**BALLOTS LEFT TO BE COUNTED  
JUNE 7, 2016 PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION**

Mendocino County Assessor-County Clerk-Recorder Susan M. Ranochak announced that as with any other election, there are ballots left to be processed as part of the official canvass. Mendocino County has 15,567 Vote By Mail ballots to process, and 958 Provisional ballots to review and process.

Of the outstanding ballots left to count, the approximate breakdowns for the Supervisorial District are as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> Supervisorial District – 2,800 ballots; 2<sup>nd</sup> Supervisorial District – 2,615; 3<sup>rd</sup> Supervisorial District – 2,494 ballots; 4<sup>th</sup> Supervisorial District – 4,456 ballots (of which 1,582 are for the City of Fort Bragg) & 5<sup>th</sup> Supervisorial District – 4,160 ballots.

Per State law, we have 30 days to complete the canvass. The Statement of Vote, which breaks down results by precinct, will be available at that time.
