***MENDOCINO COUNTY REQUESTING INFORMATION RELATED TO WATER SUPPLY  
AND CONSERVATION MEASURES***

On January 7, 2014, the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors approved a Resolution to Declare a Local Emergency and Imminent Threat of Disaster due to the ongoing drought. The Board appointed Supervisor Dan Hamburg and Supervisor Carre Brown to serve on an ad-hoc committee, called the "Drought Emergency Taskforce," for the purpose of assessing the needs of Mendocino County residents during this time.

On behalf of the Board of Supervisors, the Mendocino County Executive Office is requesting further information from residents living in the County's unincorporated areas and who are unserved by a city or a water district. Specifically, if you are concerned about your water supply, please call the Mendocino County Water Agency Drought Hotline at 707-463-4589, and press 1 to leave a voicemail for our staff with your callback information, area of residence in the County, and a summary of your water supply situation. This information will be used as part of the Drought Emergency Taskforce information gathering phase and to collaborate with State and local partners to address the needs of County residents.
