From there, click on the link titled "CalOES Listing of Resources for Drought-Stricken Residents" to see the various State assistance programs available. This information includes services for seniors and adults with disabilities who may be having extra difficulties due to low or depleted amounts of water in their personal wells.

The County also continues to monitor the drought hotline voicemails at 707-463-4589 for people who are living in the unincorporated areas of the County and are not eligible to be served by a city, water district, or private or mutual water purveyor. Finally, the County's Drought Ad Hoc Committee will be meeting on March 12 at 1:00 p.m. at the Farm Advisor's Conference Room. This meeting is publicly noticed and open to all residents.
