LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS OF MENDOCINO COUNTY SPONSORING JULY 12 BUDGET PRESENTATION AT FORT BRAGG TOWN HALL

The Executive Office is pleased to announce that the League of Women Voters of Mendocino County will host a budget presentation delivered by the County Chief Executive Officer, Carmel J. Angelo, at the Fort Bragg Town Hall on Friday, July 12, 2013 from 10:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The presentation is the first in a series of five presentations that will be given in each supervisorial district before the County budget hearings, beginning on September 9, 2013.

Supervisor Dan Gjerde volunteered to have his district, the fourth district, be the first to receive these budget presentations. He had the following to say regarding the event: "In times when revenues are stagnant, the balanced budget represents an organization that is constantly looking for new ways to achieve its goals at lower costs."

The League of Women Voters of Mendocino County President Jane Person was pleased to offer sponsorship for the event on the group's behalf, stating "The League of Women Voters of Mendocino County is happy to host this budget presentation as part of its educational outreach to help inform County voters."

The presentation will include highlights of the County's 2013/2014 Recommended Budget, a *State of the County* update, and items of interest in the fourth district. It is hoped that those interested in performing their civic duty will continue to stay engaged in the workings of local government.
