ANDERSON VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT SPONSORING AUGUST 21 BUDGET PRESENTATION AT BOONVILLE FAIRGROUNDS DINING HALL

The Executive Office is pleased to announce that the Anderson Valley Community Services District will host a budget presentation delivered by the County Chief Executive Officer, Carmel J. Angelo, and the Assistant Chief Executive Officer, Kyle C. Knopp, at the Boonville Fairgrounds Dining Hall on Wednesday, August 21, 2013 from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. The presentation is the fourth in a series of five presentations that will be given in each supervisorial district before the County's Final Budget hearings, beginning on September 9, 2013.

The elected Supervisor for the 5th District, Dan Hamburg, had the following to say about the August 21st presentation in his district: "The budget is the clearest expression of the responsibilities and the priorities of county government. This is a chance for the people of Anderson Valley to learn where we're headed and to alter that direction where appropriate. I'm hoping for a good turnout on August 21!"

The Chair of the Anderson Valley Community Services District, Valerie Hanelt, was pleased to offer sponsorship for the event on the service district's behalf, stating "We appreciate the Fifth District holding the budget presentation in Anderson Valley and encourage everyone to attend so they can ask about Anderson Valley issues."

It is hoped that those interested in performing their civic duty will continue to stay engaged in the workings of local government.
