POTTER VALLEY YOUTH AND COMMUNITY CENTER SPONSORING AUGUST 14 BUDGET PRESENTATION AT POTTER VALLEY COMMUNITY UNITED METHODIST CHURCH

The Executive Office is pleased to announce that the Potter Valley Youth and Community Center (PVYCC) will host a budget presentation delivered by the County Chief Executive Officer, Carmel J. Angelo, and the Assistant Chief Executive Officer, Kyle C. Knopp, at the Potter Valley Community United Methodist Church on Wednesday, August 14, 2013 from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. The presentation is the second in a series of five presentations that will be given in each supervisorial district before the County's Final Budget hearings, beginning on September 9, 2013.

The elected Supervisor for the 1st District, Carre Brown, had the following to say about the August 14th presentation in her district: "It is important to have people engaged in crucial budget matters for their local government outside the normal hearing process. This County budget presentation brings the information direct to the Community, and attempts to make the details of the proposed budget understandable for all of our residents."
