Ukiah, California, August 2, 2011 – On August 16, 2011, the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors will meet at Fort Bragg Town Hall, 363 N. Main Street, in Fort Bragg, California, for a regularly scheduled meeting.

Despite continued fiscal challenges, it is the consensus of the Board of Supervisors to fulfill their commitment to the county's outlying communities by continuing the policy of off-site meetings, affording constituents in every district an opportunity to participate in their local government.

Beginning in 2006, the Board's adopted annual calendar has called for up to three of its regularly scheduled meetings to be held in outlying areas of the county. The focus has been the Fourth and Fifth Districts on the coast, and the North County, encompassing District Three. Meetings have been held in Fort Bragg, Willits, Gualala, Point Arena, Covelo, and Boonville over the past five years.

"Fort Bragg as a core coastal population and commerce center provides excellent access for coastal residents to the Board of Supervisors", states Kendall Smith, 4th District Supervisor and Board Chair. Chair Smith continues, "On August 16th, at approximately 10:00 a.m., the Board of Supervisors will conduct one of two public hearings on county redistricting. The Board will also receive the Mental Health Board Annual Report. Fort Bragg Mayor Dave Turner will offer opening remarks. Please review the online agenda available Friday, August 12, 2011, for complete meeting details."

The Board meeting on August 16, 2011, is scheduled to begin at 10:00 a.m. and is anticipated to adjourn mid-afternoon. The public is welcome and invited to attend all Board meetings.
