***IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM CEO ANGELO REGARDING BOARD ACTION TO JOIN THE
NATIONAL MOMENT OF REMEMBRANCE OF THE 10TH ANNIVERSARY OF SEPTEMBER 11***

On August 23, 2011, the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors unanimously adopted Resolution No. 11-124 joining the "National Moment of Remembrance" of the 10th anniversary of September 11th.

The Mendocino County Board of Supervisors wholeheartedly supports the effort to come together as a Nation and cease all work or other activity for a moment of remembrance.

Beginning at 10:00 a.m. Pacific Standard Time, on September 11, 2011, all firehouses, law enforcement agencies, and places of worship are asked to sound sirens and ring bells for one minute. As sirens and bells ring out, persons across the country are asked to stop and honor those we lost in the attacks.

On the 10th anniversary of this tragic day, the thoughts of the people of the United States are with all of the victims of the events of September 11, 2001, and their families.
