## ***ASSEMBLYMEMBER WESLEY CHESBRO TO ADDRESS THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS***

The Mendocino County Board of Supervisors will receive a presentation by Assemblymember Wesley Chesbro, representing the 1<sup>st</sup> Assembly District, on October 25.

Chesbro is slated to provide an “end of session” legislative wrap-up, share insight into happenings in the State Legislature, and highlight priorities for the 1<sup>st</sup> Assembly District when the legislature reconvenes in January 2012.

*“Hearing from our State elected officials provides invaluable insight into the Sacramento legislative process, now, more important than ever,”* stated Board Chair, Kendall Smith, 4<sup>th</sup> District Supervisor. *“The Board is fortunate to have this opportunity to dialogue with Assemblymember Chesbro, to convey our greatest concerns and highest priorities for Mendocino County; he is acutely aware of the challenges faced by rural counties throughout the State, and we are lucky to have him in our corner.”*

Chesbro (D-Arcata) has represented the 1<sup>st</sup> Assembly District since 2009, previously serving as our State Senator from 1998-2006. Chesbro has announced his intent to run for reelection in 2012 in the newly formed 2<sup>nd</sup> Assembly District, a result of recent legislative redistricting.
