STATE SENATOR NOREEN EVANS TO ADDRESS THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

The Mendocino County Board of Supervisors will receive a presentation by State Senator Noreen Evans, representing the 2nd Senatorial District, on Tuesday, December 18, 2012.

Evans is slated to provide an "end of session" legislative wrap-up, share insight into happenings in the State Legislature, and highlight priorities for the 2nd Senatorial District when the legislature reconvenes in January 2013.

"Hearing from our State elected officials provides invaluable insight into the Sacramento legislative process, now, more important than ever," stated Carre Brown, 1st District Supervisor and the Board's appointee to CSAC. *"The Board is fortunate to have this opportunity to engage in a discussion with Senator Evans to convey our concerns and priorities for Mendocino County. Senator Evans is a strong advocate for rural counties and is intimately aware of the challenges faced by local government."*

Senator Evans has represented the 2nd Senatorial District since 2011, covering Humboldt, Lake, Mendocino, Marin and Sonoma counties. Senator Evans previously served in the State Assembly from 2004-2010. Prior to her election to the Assembly in 2004, Senator Evans served two terms on the Santa Rosa City Council.
