MENDOCINO COUNTY HOLIDAY DEPARTMENT SCHEDULES

Mendocino County Libraries and Bookmobile Schedules to Change Over the Holidays

Ukiah, CA December 8th, 2011. All Mendocino Library branches will be closed the week after Christmas. They will open again Saturday December 31st. When they re-open they will be on a new expanded schedule. The Mendocino County Traveling Branch (bookmobile) will be out-of-service until January 23rd because of mechanical failure.

Fort Bragg and Ukiah branches will join Willits and Coast Community in adding an additional day of service. Ukiah will be reopening on Wednesdays from ten to five. Fort Bragg will be reopening Thursdays from ten to six. Coast Library opened again for Fridays and Willits added hours on Thursdays this month.

Willits has also renewed its Thursday morning children's hour. Ukiah will begin a new Wednesday Story time. For more information community members may call their local library or see www.mendolibrary.org for details.

In addition to the change in the hours of operation for the library the following departments will also have a modified schedule over the holidays:

General Services Agency: Closed December 22, 23 and 30th.

Museum: Closed on Saturday/December 24, Sunday/December 25, and Sunday/January 1.

Probation: closing at 3pm the Friday preceding Xmas and New Year.

Public Defender: Ukiah and Ft Bragg closed Dec. 27th through the 30th.
