The workshop will be held at the Mendocino County Farm Advisor/Farm Advisor Conference Room at 890 North Bush Street (corner of Low Gap Road and Bush Street) starting at 1:30 pm.


“Water is critical to Mendocino County’s future,” said Third District Supervisor John Pinches. “It is real important that the people come out and get interested in this workshop.”
