***BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MOVE FORWARD WITH
THE MENDOCINO TOWN PLAN UPDATE***

Ukiah, California... August 7, 2007

At the August 7, 2007 Board meeting the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors resumed discussions regarding the Mendocino Town Plan Update. Staff was directed to begin work on a revising the Mendocino Town Plan, with a finalized product to be presented to the Board in four months.

Second district Supervisor Jim Wattenburger vocalized his support for moving forward with the project, "Let's start checking off the plans that have been hanging in the wind for so long."

The project will require the services of an extra-help senior planner, who will review the current documents, data collection and charting, prepare plan update drafts, schedule community meetings, present monthly updates to the Board on progress, and present the finished product to the Planning Commission and the Board of Supervisors for adoption of the Update.

It is anticipated that the Mendocino Town Plan Update will be completed by December of 2007.

Supervisor Colfax indicated his support of the proposal. "This is a long overdue update of the Mendocino Town Plan, I'm looking forward to a cooperative effort by the people in the community to resolve some of the issues that have been a source of longtime concern."
