Mendocino County Community Health Services will hold free H1N1 vaccination clinics in March in Ukiah, 1120 S. Dora St.

**Monday, March 15<sup>th</sup>,**

No appointment is required and there is no charge. The clinics are open to anyone over six months of age. All children under 10 years of age need to receive 2 vaccinations, 28 days apart in order to be fully immunized.

California Department of Public Health still recommends H1N1 vaccination for everyone 6 months and older.
