## COUNTY OF MENDOCINO ANNOUNCES SELECTION OF NEW DIRECTOR OF HUMAN RESOURCES

The Chief Executive Officer of Mendocino County announced today that Teresia Haase has been selected as the County of Mendocino's new Director of Human Resources. *"There are a number of challenges ahead for Teresia and her new team as the County is experiencing an unemployment rate that has not been seen in Mendocino County for many decades; there are also budget issues facing the County of Mendocino and California,"* stated CEO Tom Mitchell. *"Teresia's experience will be a tremendous asset and we look forward to her arrival on October 18."*
