H1N1 COMMUNITY MEETINGS

Ukiah, CA –Mendocino County has had 17 H1N1 related hospitalizations and two deaths. With the seasonal flu season fast approaching, H1N1 cases are expected to increase county wide. In response, Mendocino County Community Health Services (CHS) is conducting town hall style H1N1 Community meetings next week in Ukiah, Willits, and Fort Bragg.

Anyone seeking information and education on H1N1 is welcome to attend. The meetings will be conducted by Stacey Cryer, CHS Director, and Public Health Officer Dr. Marvin Trotter. Cryer will discuss the role of CHS in dealing with this type of community health issue, and Dr. Trotter will give an H1N1 presentation covering topics including symptoms, high risk categories, and vaccination. There will also be time dedicated to answering questions from the community. No reservations are required.
