Legislative State Watchlist for Mendocino County*

Kendall Smith, Chair of the Board General Government Committee and Fourth District Supervisor, introduced the 2009 State Legislative Watchlist today, stating, "This is a great tool for tracking State bills that are of interest to Mendocino County." The watchlist was designed by the General Government Committee, a standing subcommittee of the Board of Supervisors, in conjunction with Mendocino County Executive Office staff. It provides a summary of designated State Assembly and Senate Bills, indicates organizations that oppose or support them, as well as lists County actions taken. Carre Brown, First District Supervisor, commented, "This list will be very helpful for the public to see what we're monitoring and what we're supporting."
