Subject: **Thermometer Calibration**

The Agricultural Commissioner will provide for its annual calibration of growers' orchard thermometers for accuracy.

Growers wishing to have their thermometers checked should deliver them to the Mendocino County Agricultural Commissioner's Office at **890 N. Bush Street** prior to 5:00 p.m. on **Tuesday, February 23, 2010**. The thermometers may be picked up anytime on **Thursday, February 25, 2010**. Office hours are from 8:00 to 12:00 and 1:00 to 5:00.

Upon delivery, growers will be asked to attach a name tag to each thermometer. Attach the tag to the top end (not the bulb end) using string. Do not use rubber bands or wire. Thermometers must be clean of chemicals and dust or they will not be tested. They should be stored bulb-end down in a sturdy box.
