■ PREVIOUS BOARD/BOARD COMMITTEE ACTIONS: By Resolution No 16-003 (January 5, 2016) Board accepted Traffic Study No 15-01 recommending the establishment of a 25 miles per hour (MPH) prima facie speed limit on Laytonville Dos Rios Road, CR 322.							
■ SUMMARY OF REQUEST: Area residents concerned about speeding on Laytonville Dos Rios Road from Mile Post (MP) 11.22 to MP 12.00 submitted a petition to the Road Commissioner for a speed study. The Road Commissioner found the application meritorious and authorized a traffic study. The recommendation of Traffic Study No 15-01 is to establish a 25 MPH prima facie speed limit on Laytonville Dos Rios Road from MP 11.22 to MP 12.00.
