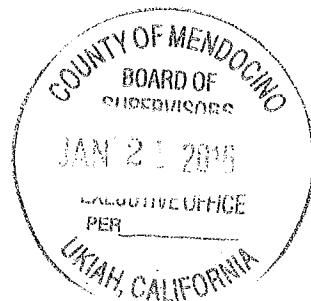

**PROPOSED ORDINANCE  
ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER  
3.12 OF TITLE 3  
REGARDING THE COUNTY  
VEHICLE POLICY**

This ordinance amends Mendocino County Code Chapter 3.12 of Title 3 regarding the responsibilities and rules for the use of County owned and leased vehicles. It replaces the Director of General Services and that agency with the Chief Executive Officer and that office and gives all authority and responsibilities of the General Services Office to the County Executive Office. The proposed ordinance is scheduled for adoption on February 2, 2016. A complete copy of the ordinance is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and is available for inspection and copying as a public record.
