AGENDA TITLE: Approval of Amendment to Board of Supervisors (BOS) Agreement No. 15-084 with Mendocino County Youth Project, Increasing the Original Amount of \$134,940 by \$34,086 for a New Total Amount of \$169,026 to Provide Transitional Supportive Housing Services to an Expanded Group of Young Adults, Ages 18-21, in Fiscal Year 2015-16								
PREVIOUS BOARD/BOARD COMMITTEE ACTIONS: The Board approved Agreement #BOS 15-084 on August 18, 2015.								
 SUMMARY OF REQUEST: In Mendocino County, qualified youth, ages 18-21, may participate in the Extended Foster Care program through Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) Family and Children's Services (FCS). HHSA collaborates with Mendocino County Youth Project (MCYP) to provide emergency housing to non-minor dependent young adults who have voluntarily chosen to remain in the foster care system, but currently have no housing. This Amendment will allow MCYP to provide services to an expanded group of young adults that will include the general homeless population of transition age youth, ages 18-21, who are in need of temporary shelter and supportive services.
