On November 19, 2014 the County released letters of intent to bid and received notice of intent to apply from Long Valley Fire Protection District, Covelo Fire District and Anderson Valley Ambulance. On May 5, 2015 the Board approved MOUs for each service provider to form partnerships with existing providers within the County to meet the objective of enhancing and/or sustaining existing emergency medical services in the areas they serve. Additional funds will allow for the continuation of these partnerships until such time that the Exclusive Operating Area (EOA) project is authorized and completed and a service provider contract entered established. This will be addressed during the FY 2016-17 budget process in more detail.
