AGENDA TITLE: Approval of Letter of Support to Legislators for Senate Bill 1288 (Leno) - Local Options for Elections

PREVIOUS BOARD/BOARD COMMITTEE ACTIONS: No previous action.

■ SUMMARY OF REQUEST: Senate Bill (SB) 1288 would allow cities and counties to adopt majority winner voting methods without having to go to the expense of a traditional two round run-off election. Change to a majority winner voting method is entirely voluntary and requires voter approval from the voters of each local jurisdiction in order to be enacted. Currently, many local elections do not provide for a run-off, so multiple candidates may split the vote resulting in the election of candidates who received less than 50% of the vote. Alternately, jurisdictions like Mendocino County that conduct run-off elections, must often hold two elections to determine a winner.

SB 1288 will allow local jurisdictions the option to adopt ranked choice voting which allows voters to rank the candidates in order of preference which allows a majority winner to be determined in a single election without a costly second election. This system also allows the election to be scheduled at the same time as the state general election, which traditionally has a higher turnout than the June primary. Supervisor John McCowen requests that the Board of Supervisors approve a letter of support for SB 1288.
