■ AGENDA TITLE: Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Mental Health Services Act Housing Presentation and the 2016 Mental Health System Housing Funds Feedback/Results Survey						
■ Previous Board/Board Committee Actions: On May 3, 2016, the Board of Supervisors discussed the status of adult mental health services transition and related activities. Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Housing Feedback Survey Results were presented to the Board of Supervisors. The Board of Supervisors requested additional information regarding the topic.						
■ SUMMARY OF REQUEST: Mendocino County Mental Health has funds for permanent supported Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) housing through MHSA which must be spent by 2018. MHSA conducted a survey as a part of the required Community Program Planning Process, to collect feedback from stakeholders on how to prioritize the use of these funds. Presentations were made to stakeholders, and a 30 day survey was conducted regarding potential options. Options have been outlined by the contract partner, Rural Communities Housing Development Corporation (RCHDC), as use of Mendocino County funds alone, or leveraging funds with tax credits for larger complexes, and if so, whether to prioritize special needs clients versus all low income candidates for the additional units (a certain number of MHSA units would be guaranteed). The survey results from 150 stakeholders prioritized leveraging funds in one location (Ukiah was preferred), with mixed use MHSA and all low income tenants. Part of the MHSA funds must be used to sustain the supportive component for 15-20 years.
