**RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH & RECOVERY SERVICES DIRECTOR TO ACCEPT THE SENATE BILL (SB) 82, INVESTMENT IN MENTAL HEALTH WELLNESS GRANT PROGRAM FINAL ALLOCATION THIRD ROUND FUNDING (CRISIS RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT (CRT)) GRANT AWARD OF \$500,000 FROM THE CALIFORNIA HEALTH FACILITIES FINANCING AUTHORITY (CHFFA)**

WHEREAS, Health and Human Services Agency's Behavioral Health and Recovery Services has been awarded an Investment in Mental Health Wellness Grant Program in the amount of \$500,000; and

WHEREAS, this grant will fund a 10 bed Crisis Residential Treatment (CRT) Program; and

WHEREAS, this funding will increase capacity for a clinically effective and cost efficient alternative to psychiatric hospitalization for individuals ages 18 and over experiencing a mental health crisis; and

WHEREAS, the grant period begins on June 25, 2015 and will end June 30, 2016 unless the grant is extended by the California Health Facilities Financing Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Mendocino County Behavioral Health & Recovery Services Director to accept the funding from California Health Facilities Financing Authority's Investment in Mental Health Wellness Grant Program; and authorize the Behavioral Health & Recovery Services Director to sign any future amendments to the grant that do not affect the annual maximum amount.
