SUMMARY OF REQUEST: In 2013, Mendocino County initiated a collaborative project to explore the feasibility of implementing an Exclusive Operating Area (EOA) for the sustainable provision of emergency ambulance services within the County. Pursuant to Board direction, an EOA Oversight Committee, comprised of representatives from various County offices, fire chiefs and hospital staff, solicited input from emergency transport providers, dispatch providers, fire chiefs and hospitals to discuss best methods and system design of an EOA. On September, 23, 2014, the County entered into an agreement with The Abaris Group to develop and implement an ambulance exclusive operating area (EOA) for inland Mendocino County ambulance ordinance. Changes to the ordinance include establishing an EOA, the addition of the Local Emergency Medical Services Authority (LEMSA) as opposed to "health officer" and "EMS Agency", language updates for a more concise and reflective ordinance and removal of language duplicative of EMS Standard Operating Procedures. At the time the ordinance was initially written, ambulance services provided their own dispatch services. However, as this is no longer the case, language related to dispatch has been removed from the Ordinance.
