**SUBJECT:** MOU between the California Air Resources Board and the Air Quality

Management District Regarding Implementation and Enforcement of the State

Green House Gas Landfill Regulation

Pursuant to AB 32, the Global Warming Solutions Act of 2006, ARB is the state agency charged with monitoring and regulating sources of emissions of greenhouse gases that cause global warming. (California Health and Safety Code, § 38510)

The proposed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the California Air Resource Board and the Mendocino County Air Quality Management District is the first in a series of MOUs negotiated by the California Air Pollution Control Officers Association (CAPCOA) and ARB related to the enforcement of Green House Gas (GHG) regulations and Diesel regulations in California.

The proposed MOU regarding Implementation and Enforcement of Regulations to Reduce Methane Emissions from Municipal Solid Waste Landfills (MSW) authorizes the District to conduct inspections, charge fees for associated costs, and assess penalties (if necessary) for Municipal Solid Waste Landfills in Mendocino County to ensure compliance with the requirements of the state Green House Gas Regulation affecting Municipal Solid Waste Landfills. (California Code of Regulations, title 17, subchapter 10, article 4, Subarticle 6, Sections 95460 to 95476)

The proposed MOU will not change any of the compliance requirements of the state regulation – it simply authorizes the District to enforce the regulation at the local level.

At this time, the only facility in Mendocino County that may be subject to <u>all</u> of the requirements of this regulation is the City of Ukiah Landfill. The remaining MSW landfills are subject to a lower level of reporting and monitoring requirements. Wood waste landfills (aka "Bark Dumps") are not subject to this regulation.

All training requirements for District staff will be provided by ARB. Costs related to enforcement of the regulation outlined in the MOU for additional staff time (inspections, reporting and training) will be offset by Technical Services fees charged at the District's hourly rate.

The District is requesting Board authorization for the Air Pollution Control Officer to sign the Memorandum of Understanding with the Air Resources Board (ARB) regarding implementation and enforcement of the state Green House Gas Regulation affecting Municipal Solid Waste Landfills.
