Vehicle Code) section 12527(d)(2)) to exempt certain "Ambulance Drivers" as outlined in Title 13 section 12527(d)(1) from the requirement of obtaining "emergency medical training" within one year of being licensed to drive an ambulance. The request must be from both the county Board of Supervisors, and any one of the following: the Public Health Officer, The Emergency Medical Care Committee (EMCC), or the EMS Coordinator. Need is due to the limited availability of volunteers wishing to provide donated time and/or service to the ambulance provider in anything other than a "driver" role.
