■ AGENDA TITLE: Adoption of Resolution Approving and Executing Caltrans Relinquishment Agreement with the County for a Short Segment of U.S. 101 at Post Mile (PM) 47.522 to PM 48.721 (Willits Area)			
■ PREVIOUS BOARD/BOARD COMMITTEE ACTIONS: On November 13, 1968, the Chair of the Board of Supervisors (BOS) executed a new Freeway Agreement with Caltrans from Post Mile (PM) 42.6 to PM 47.4 on State Route 101 (SR-101) and on November 18, 1971, the BOS executed a new Freeway Agreement with Caltrans from PM 47.4 to PM 55.3 on SR-101. On September 23, 2008, the BOS approved and executed a new Freeway Agreement from Post Mile (PM) 42.5 near the Haehl Overhead			
to PM 49.0 near the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Crossing. Each of these agreements were for the support of the Willits Bypass.			
Summary of Request: This portion of U.S. 101, PM 47.522 to PM 48.721, will be bypassed and therefore no longer appropriate to be retained in the State maintenance system. During the processing of this project, various consents may be necessary on the part of the County, thus the applicable Resolution proposes the County Director of Transportation be authorized to execute, on behalf of the County of Mendocino, project related technical reviews, permissions, permits, etc. which do not result in a cost or liability to the County but are necessary for orderly and efficient processing of this project.
