AGENDA TITLE: Adoption of Resolution Approving Payment of a Portion of Repair Costs to the City of Willits for Emergency Repairs to Sherwood Road (Fiscal Year 2011/12) (Brooktrails Area)

- PREVIOUS BOARD/BOARD COMMITTEE ACTIONS: In 2000, cost sharing with the City of Willits for Sherwood Road improvements was appropriated during Budget hearings.
- SUMMARY OF REQUEST: The City of Willits has presented the Mendocino County Department of Transportation (MCDoT) with bid results for subject emergency repairs to Sherwood Road in the amount of \$215,531 and requested County participation in the City's emergency repair project. Sherwood Road has the highest average daily traffic of any County Road in its first four miles, which provides the only transportation service to the Brooktrails Township, of that first four miles the City of Willits maintains less than one half mile. Cracks in the road were investigated and it was determined that drainage conduits needed immediate attention. Repair work has begun and is expected to be complete before winter. Upon approval of this expenditure by the Board, MCDoT will reimburse the City of Willits for a share (approximately 23%) of expenses for emergency repairs to Sherwood Road, but will not make any future regular, routine maintenance allocation.
