<ul> <li>■ SUMMARY OF REQUEST: SAMHSA (Substance Abuse &amp; Mental Health Services Administration) awarded a 5-year, \$400,000/year Treatment for Homeless grant to HHSA to operate the "AT HOME" Program (Access to Treatment and Housing Opportunities in the Mendocino Environment). In Year 3 of the grant (Oct 2010-Sep 2011), HHSA contracted with Ukiah Community Center, Inc. (UCC) to provide intensive case management services to a caseload of 12 homeless clients in Ukiah with cooccurring mental health and substance abuse disorders. The UCC Case Manager coordinates services with an HHSA Substance Abuse Counselor and a Mental Health Counselor at Mendocino Community Health Clinic.
