On October 18, 2011, the Board of Supervisors adopted resolutions declaring surplus and authorizing the acceptance of sealed bids and/or oral bids for the sale of real property.</li> <li>■ SUMMARY OF REQUEST: Surplus land is defined as land owned by any agency of the state, or any local agency, that is determined to be no longer necessary for the agency's use, except property that is being held by the agency for the purposes of exchange. The Board of Supervisors made the declaration of property considered "surplus" and directed staff to proceed with the mandated process (GC 25526 and 25528) associated with the sale/surplus of real property, including the public noticing requirements as defined by the GC. The Board will be presented with sealed proposals, as well as entertain any oral bids prior to opening any sealed bids, during the meeting proceedings. The Board will be given the option to either accept or reject bids (GC 25530) during said meeting.
