## RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS IN SUPPORT OF ASSEMBLY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 42, MA, PROMOTING SUNDAYS AS "EAT LOCAL, BUY CALIFORNIA GROWN DAY".
