

RESOLUTION NO. 12-

RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF MENDOCINO AND THE MENDOCINO COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION (MCLEMA)

WHEREAS, the Myers-Milias-Brown Act requires that units of local governments meet and confer with employee representatives for the purpose of developing wage and fringe benefit agreements; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Mendocino have met to discuss provisions of the Memorandum of Understanding with representatives of the MENDOCINO COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION; and

WHEREAS, these representatives have agreed upon salary and benefits for the term of January 24, 2012 through June 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the salary and benefits as agreed upon will not have a negative impact on the funding status of the Mendocino County Employees Retirement System as required by Government Code Section 23026; and

WHEREAS, the agreement reached between the parties amends previously approved Memoranda of Understanding and approves the Memorandum of Understanding between the County of Mendocino and Mendocino County Law Enforcement Management Association provided as Attachment "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Mendocino County finds this agreement to be proper and suitable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors formally approves the Memorandum of Understanding, signed by representatives of the Board of Supervisors and by representatives of the MENDOCINO COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION.

The effective date of this Resolution shall be January 24, 2012.
