■ Previous Board/Board Committee Actions: The BOS approved the Caspar Transfer Station Operations Agreement & Lease [BOS No. 11-008] with Solid Wastes of Willits, Inc. on January 11, 2011.			
■ SUMMARY OF REQUEST: An addition to the contract is necessary to clarify how the County would work with SWOW to move the existing self-haul operations around the site in the event that the Caspar property was selected for development of a full-scale commercial transfer station. The amendment clarifies that the County may relocate SWOW's facilities, at County expense, to make room for construction activities. This amendment doesn't in any way imply that the Caspar site is the preferred location for this project, but it cleans up the original contract to prevent any confusion if that takes place. SWOW's president Jerry Ward signed the amendment on or about November 21, 2011. This amendment also requires the consent of the City of Fort Bragg.
