■ **AGENDA TITLE:** **Approval of Letter of Support for SB 1078 (Evans) State Parks Revenue Generation Act**

■ **PREVIOUS BOARD/BOARD COMMITTEE ACTIONS:** The Board has sent letters of support for other legislation related to keeping open State Parks in Mendocino County threatened with closure.

■ **SUMMARY OF REQUEST:** State Senator Noreen Evans has introduced Senate Bill 1078, the State Parks Revenue Generation Measure, to develop an alternate method of funding the State Park system in order to avoid the scheduled closure of State Parks, including eight located in Mendocino County. SB 1078, if enacted, would require the State Lands Commission (SLC) to develop and implement a plan to collect delinquent rents and renegotiate expired and undervalued leases of state lands. The California Auditor has reported that the SLC has failed to collect rent or renegotiate leases valued in the millions of dollars. A portion of the past due monies collected would be used to plan and implement methods of generating additional park revenues.
