NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Mendocino, in recognition of the outstanding achievements and dedicated service of the National Public Safety Telecommunications staff of the Mendocino County Sheriff's Office, hereby proclaims the week of April 8–14, 2012, in Mendocino County, as:
