## **RESOLUTION NO. 12-**

RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ADOPTING A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION, IN COMPLIANCE WITH CEQA REQUIREMENTS, FOR REPLACEMENT OF BRIDGE NO. 10C-0084 ON SCHOOL WAY, CR 236, AT M.P. 1.31 (REDWOOD VALLEY AREA)

WHEREAS, the existing bridge on School Way, CR 236, at M.P. 1.31 near Redwood Valley was built in 1967; and

WHEREAS, a seismic assessment of the School Way Bridge (No. 10C-0084) was performed in accordance with the Local Bridge Seismic Safety Retrofit Program and was found seismically deficient; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of relevant preliminary engineering studies, replacement of the bridge was found to be the appropriate strategy under the Seismic Retrofit Program: and

WHEREAS, analyses performed during project development have also identified channel scour conditions that also have rendered the School Way bridge hydraulically deficient; and

WHEREAS, during project development, provisions have been incorporated in the engineering and design considerations to mitigate the environmental impacts of replacing Bridge No. 10C-0084, including road approaches.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors finds the environmental impacts identified for Replacement of School Way Bridge No. 10C-0084 on CR 236 at M.P. 1.31 (Redwood Valley area) can be adequately mitigated through the conditions of approval and/or features of the project design so that no significant adverse environmental impacts will result from the project and therefore a Mitigated Negative Declaration is adopted.
