Mendocino County initially entered into an agreement with Sonoma County in January 1994 to provide EMS Agency Administration. Since that time we've been partners in a multi-county region, upgraded to paramedic status, developed a regional EMS Plan, developed a policy and procedure manual, obtained funds from State general funds for regional development, contracted with Fitch & Associates to complete an EMS Assessment of this county, and met with stakeholders around EMS sustainability.
