RESPONSIBILITY: Mendocino County is a General Law County governed by the Constitution of the State of California. The Mendocino Board of Supervisors is responsible for exercising its legislative and quasi-judicial authority, within budgetary constraints, to provide for the health, welfare and safety of the residents of Mendocino County. This is accomplished through regular and special Board meetings, by community outreach and interaction with their constituents, and by serving on a number of local, state, and national boards and commissions.

BACKGROUND: Supervisor Hamburg has resided in Mendocino County for 39 years and has served the community as City of Ukiah Planning Commissioner, a Mendocino County Supervisor from 1981 to 1985, and as an Executive Director of a non-profit agency. Dan was elected by the first congressional district to serve for one term to the House of Representatives, where he focused on single-payer national health care, protecting old-growth forests, and restoring fisheries.

Supervisor Hamburg currently chairs the Board's General Government Personnel/Legislative Committee, is a member of the Public Resources Committee, and represents the Board through numerous other assignments including the Caspar Transfer Station Coordinating Committee, FIRST 5 Mendocino, and CSAC Coastal Counties Regional Association.
