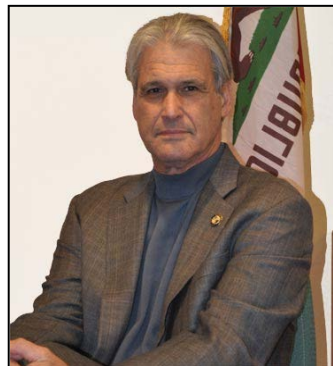

**RESPONSIBILITY:** Mendocino County is a General Law County governed by the Constitution of the State of California. The Mendocino Board of Supervisors is responsible for exercising its legislative and quasi-judicial authority, within budgetary constraints, to provide for the health, welfare and safety of the residents of Mendocino County. This is accomplished through regular and special Board meetings, by community outreach and interaction with their constituents, and by serving on a number of local, state, and national boards and commissions.

**BACKGROUND:** Supervisor Hamburg has resided in Mendocino County for 43 years and has served the community as City of Ukiah Planning Commissioner, a Mendocino County Supervisor from 1981 to 1984 and from 2011 to 2014, and as an Executive Director of North Coast Opportunities, a bi-county community action agency. Dan was elected by the first congressional district to serve for one term to the House of Representatives, where he focused on single-payer national health care, protecting old-growth forests, and restoring fisheries.

Supervisor Hamburg represents the Board through numerous assignments, including the Caspar Transfer Station Coordinating Committee, First 5 Mendocino, and CSAC Coastal Counties Regional Association.

**DISTRICT INFORMATION:** The Fifth Supervisorial District encompasses southern inland and various coastal areas of Mendocino County, representing approximately 17,000 constituents.

- Building a stronger local economy (spending locally/supporting local farmers);
