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Mendocino County Mental Health Board October 21st Meeting in Willits

The next regularly scheduled meeting of the Mental Health Board will be held Wednesday, October 21st at the Mendocino County Public Library Conference room in Willits, located at 390 E. Commercial Street. The meeting will take place in the Library conference room beginning at 10:00 AM. Members of the public are encouraged to attend these open Mental Health Board meetings to ask questions and give testimony during the public comment segment of the meetings.

Each of the five districts in the county has three seats on the MHB. Currently there are open seats in all five districts. The Mental Health Board is seeking interested applicants who are willing to serve the community.

Mental Health Board members attend monthly board meetings as well as the quarterly meeting of the Mental Health Board Special Committee for the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) programs. The regular meeting of the Mental Health Board is scheduled for the third Wednesday of the month. Meetings are held at various locations throughout the county. Mileage reimbursement is available to Board members.

To apply to become a member of the MHB for your district, complete an application and return it to either the County Clerk's office or the Mental Health Branch Administrative office, 501 Low Gap Road, Ukiah CA 95482, or fax it to 707-463-4245. Upon receipt, your application will go to the Chair of the MHB who will contact you for an interview with the board, after which a recommendation for appointment is made to the Board of Supervisors.
