### EXPANDED TARGET GROUPS FOR H1N1 VACCINATION CLINICS IN FT BRAGG AND UKIAH

Ukiah – Mendocino County Community Health Services will hold an H1N1 vaccination clinic in Fort Bragg on Monday, December 14<sup>th</sup> from 3:00 to 6:00 p.m. at Redwood Elementary School located at 324 S. Lincoln Street.

The Ukiah clinic will be held on Tuesday, December 15<sup>th</sup> from 3:30 – 6:30 p.m. at Grace Hudson Elementary School located at 251 Jefferson Lane.

Both clinics are free and no appointment is necessary. The target groups for both clinics are:

- Pregnant women
- Children 3-12 years old
- Children 13-18 years old with a chronic medical condition
- Pre-hospital medical first responders
- **Adults up to age 65 with a chronic medical condition**

Additional clinics will be scheduled throughout the county as vaccine becomes available.
