Mendocino County Mental Health Board December 16th Meeting in Ukiah

The next regularly scheduled meeting of the Mental Health Board will be held Wednesday, December 16th at the Mental Health Business Office Annex Conference Room in Ukiah, located at 880 North Bush Street. The meeting will take place in the conference room beginning at 10:00 AM. Members of the public are encouraged to attend the open Mental Health Board meeting to ask questions and give testimony during the public comment segment of the meeting.

Each of the five districts in the county has three seats on the MHB. Currently there are open seats in four of the five districts. The Mental Health Board is seeking interested applicants who are willing to serve the community.

Mental Health Board members attend monthly board meetings as well as the semi annual meetings of the Mental Health Board Special Committee for the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) programs. The regular meeting of the Mental Health Board is scheduled for the third Wednesday of the month. Meetings are held at various locations throughout the county. Mileage reimbursement is available to Board members.

To apply to become a member of the MHB for your district, complete an application and return it to either the Clerk of the Board's office or the Mental Health Branch Administrative office, 501 Low Gap Road, Ukiah CA 95482, or fax it to 707-463-4245. Upon receipt, your application will go to the Chair of the MHB who will contact you for an interview with the board, after which a recommendation for appointment is made to the Board of Supervisors.
