FREE H1N1 VACCINATION CLINICS OPEN TO EVERYONE

Mendocino County Community Health Services will hold the following H1N1 vaccination clinics in February:

Ukiah-Tuesday, February 23rd,

4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Mendocino Community Health Services,

Potter Valley-Thursday February 25th,

3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Potter Valley Elementary/Jr. High School,

10401 Main St., Potter Valley

No appointment is required and there is no charge. The clinics are open to anyone over six months of age. All children under 10 years of age need to receive 2 vaccinations, 28 days apart in order to be fully immunized.

California Department of Public Health still recommends H1N1 vaccination for everyone 6 months and older.
