Seasonal Flu Vaccine Clinics at Ft Bragg, Willits and Ukiah Senior Centers

The Mendocino County HHSA,, Community Health Services (Public Health)

will hold Seasonal Flu Vaccine Clinics at Senior Centers in Ft Bragg, Willits

and Ukiah. Seasonal flu vaccine at these clinics is available and

recommended for anyone 19 years and older. Also available is the

pneumococcal vaccine for those 65 years and older. There is a suggested

donation of \$10.00 per shot. The clinics will be held at:

- Ft Bragg Senior Center, 490 North Harold St., on Wednesday, September 29, 2010 from 10 AM to 1 PM
- Willits Senior Center, 1501 Baechtel Rd, on Tuesday, October 5, 2010 from 9 AM to Noon
- Ukiah Senior Center, Bartlett Hall, 495 Leslie St., Wednesday, October 6, 2010 from 9 AM to Noon.

Although we will not be vaccinating children at these clinics, it is encouraged

for persons 6 months and older to get vaccinated for the flu as soon as

possible to help protect against the seasonal flu. Please contact your

pediatrician, physician or Community Health Services for an appointment to get children's flu vaccine.

Seasonal Flu Vaccine is ESPECIALLY recommended for those with chronic health conditions such as: Diabetes, HIV, lung disease, kidney disease, heart disease, chronic liver disease, long term aspirin therapy, spinal cord injuries, seizure disorders, immune compromised and persons with neuromuscular disorders.
