Mental Health Board Special Meeting
October 31, 2011 in Ukiah

The next scheduled meeting for the Mental Health Board (MHB) is a "Special" meeting on Monday, Oct. 31st, at 11:00 a.m. at the County Administration Building, in Conference Room C, located at 501 Low Gap Road, in Ukiah. This meeting will address a current issue at hand; the possibility of Adoption of Laura's Law in Mendocino County. Members of the public are encouraged to attend the meeting to ask questions and give testimony during the public comment segment. Each of the five county districts has three seats on the MHB. Currently there are open seats in three of the five districts for which the MHB is seeking interested applicants.
