Wednesday October 26, 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.
Monday October 31, 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.
- **Willits** Community Health Services (Public Health) at 221 B S. Lenore St
Wednesday October 19, 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.

Although we will not be vaccinating children at the walk-in clinics, the California Immunization Branch's recommendation is that children and adolescents 6 months through 18 years also get the seasonal flu vaccine.
