### Home for the Holidays Pet Sale

Home for the Holidays is the wish of every dog and cat in the Ukiah Shelter. In order to help this happen, Mendocino County Animal Care Services is offering a fantastic end of the year event starting Tuesday November 14 and continuing through Saturday, December 31st. Cats and kittens will be able to go home for only \$25. Dogs and puppies will have the low adoption fee of \$50, plus \$25 for a dog license if you live in Mendocino County. All adopted animals are spayed and neutered, up to date on their vaccines, and micro chipped. Felines are tested for FeLV/FIV and adult dogs are tested for heartworm. All adoptions include a free wellness exam at local, participating vets.

The Ukiah Shelter located at 298 Plant Road is open for adoptions Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. as well as Wednesday from 10:00 a.m. - 6:30 p.m.
