### **HHSA MOVES ALL FT BRAGG SERVICES TO AVILA CENTER**

In January 2012 Mendocino County Health and Human Services Agency will be moving all Fort Bragg staff and services to the Avila Center on South Franklin Street in Fort Bragg. Employment and Family Assistance Services will be located at 764 So. Franklin Street, Family and Children’s Services and Mental Health will be located at 790 So Franklin Street, and Adult and Aging Services (APS, IHSS, and GA) will be located in 752 So Franklin Street.

The move should be completed by January 23, 2012. During this process HHSA asks for the public’s patience and understanding as they try to continue to provide services during this time period.
